








What Is Dynamics 365?


Microsoft Dynamics 365 consists of many cloud-based intelligent business applications, including ERP & CRM applications in one portfolio.

This means your teams, business processes, & systems can be integrated & work seamlessly together so you can gain visibility throughout your organization to help drive growth.

Dynamics 365 – Finance & Supply Chain





- Dynamics 365 Finance & Supply Chain Management (F&SCM) is Microsoft's ERP solution for midsize & large organizations. It's primarily known for meeting the complex needs of production & distribution companies that operate globally
- F&SCM has a long history behind it, dating back to 1998, when the solution, then called Axapta, was launched under a collaboration between Damgaard Data & IBM.
- In 2017, changed the name to Dynamics 365 for Finance & Operations (which was a widely used name)
- In 2020, Finance was split into two applications:
 - Dynamics 365 Finance
 - Dynamics 365 Supply Chain Management
- Note that Microsoft lets you host these ERP systems on-premises or in the cloud. In addition, F&SCM can be natively integrated with other Microsoft solutions, such as CRM, sales, service, & marketing applications




- Is it a re-implementation or an upgrade?

Upgrade Process








Upgrade Details

- What is the upgrade?
 - Tools to help bring forward existing customizations
 - Data upgrade process that you can use to bring your database forward
- Deprecated features cannot be upgraded
- Only supported from Dynamics AX 2012 R2 or R3 (can migrate from 2009 to 2012 but that is a significant effort)



Upgrade Overview





FORVIS Recommendations

- Review customizations before bringing them into Dynamics 365 be purposeful
- Consolidate code into one layer & model
- Clean up database prior to migrating
 - Staging tables
 - Temp tables
- Consider archiving to data warehouse





