Overview – Transfer Tax System

- Tax on Transfers in life or in death 40% transfer tax
- Annual Exclusion
 - \$16,000 2022
 - \$17,000 2023
- Lifetime Exemption
 - \$12,060,000 2022
 - \$12,920,000 2023
- GST Exemption
 - \$12,060,000 2022
 - \$12,920,000 2023
- Sunset after 2025 approximately 6.8 million
- Impact on Trust planning







Types of Trusts

Spousal Lifetime Access Trust (SLAT)







Charitable Trusts

Irrevocable Life Insurance Trust (ILIT)

- Irrevocable trust set up to hold one or more life insurance policies to avoid federal estate tax
- Funded in one of two ways
 - Transfer an existing policy
 - Buy a new policy
- Gift Tax Consequences




Dynasty Trust
