


Trending by New York State Funding Agency








SED Trending – Revenue



Proposed Changes to Rate Setting

- Included in NYS Budget
 - Provision to allow PS, SA, & Special Act SD to retain surpluses
 - + 11% for next 3 years, then 8%, then 5%, then 2% thereafter
 - + Problems/Questions
 - > Done after reconciliation which would remove any surplus
 - Bills being proposed to clean up this language
 - > Who has that kind of surplus anyway?
 - > Wasn't the 11% COLA needed for teaching staff salaries?
 - + Not approval of the 11% COLA Done with methodology approval
 - > Misunderstanding created that schools are being given COLAs





School Age Full Day Program




Pre-School Full Day Program




SED – Clinical Staff Productivity
